

Copay/Coinsurance plan with benefit levels

A set copay helps you plan when you will pay and how much it will cost. Plus, with separate benefit levels, it's easy to find the right doctor at the lowest cost.

What you'll pay

Copay

A copay is a set amount you pay when you visit the doctor or pick up a prescription. The amount depends on where you get care and the benefit level. The lower the level, the less your copay will be. You can find the amounts on your member ID card.

Coinsurance

You might have to pay a portion of services that aren't covered with a copay. This is called coinsurance. For example, you might pay 20% of the cost of an MRI, and your plan would cover the remaining 80%. Just like copays, your coinsurance will be smaller at a lower benefit level.

Out-of-pocket maximum

This puts a cap on what you have to pay during the year. Once you reach the max, your plan pays for all in-network care.
